This document provides step-by-step instructions to staff on how to properly arrange, connect, & start up the autonoMEgo system.

<u>|</u>|[[] STARTED

Roll the autonoMEgo unit to the user's preferred side of the bed & lock the casters in place.



Connect the 1/4" Nurse Call Cable from the back plate of the unit to the wall mounted alert.





Connect the phone cord from the back plate to an analog phone jack.





Connect the DB25 cable to the back plate for bed control. Plug the other cable into the bed's hand pendant port.








SET UP CONTINUED

Remove Sip & Puff (Dual) from the side holder on the *autonoMEgo* unit & attach it to the bed side rails.








For SWITCH use, unplug the Sip & Puff (Dual). Plug a 3.5mm splitter into the jack on the back plate. This will allow the use of individual switches. Plug the switches into the splitter.

SET UP CONTINUED

Plug the power cord at the base of the *autonoMEgo* unit into a nearby grounded outlet.



Turn on the *autonoME* ECU box by switching the red button from "**0**" to "**I**".



Once the computer starts up, the *autonoME* software will open automatically. If it does not start, you can manually open it by selecting the icon in the taskbar, near the **Start** button.



On the Main Menu of the autonoME Software choose "Settings" & set-up the user's preferred input method(s), i.e., voice, switch/sip & puff, &/or eye gaze.



SET UP COMPLETE


Position the screen at the appropriate distance & height for the user. *When using eye gaze, the optimal distance is between 23" & 26".



Turn the IR device (UIRT) located at the top of the autonoMEgo unit & position towards the room television in order to control the TV with the device.



Have the user test the bed controls, nurse call, & other functions.
